## His Grace Prayer

HiS: Holy Spirit—Ask God to send His Holy Spirit to guide you in your time of prayer.

G: Gratitude—spend some time giving thanks to God for all His blessings in your life. Look for those moments when you were particularly aware of God in your day. Spend some time simply talking to God and thanking Him for whatever you are most grateful today.

R: Reflect—on the past day: when have you lived your faith, when have you not. Spend some time talking to God about these situations and what you learned from them.

A: Accept—that you are not perfect, ask God to forgive you for any wrong you may have done, ask Him to let you know His peace, mercy and love. Ask God to give you the courage to seek the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

C: Change—what is God asking you to change in your life. Spend some talking to God about the significant moments in your day and what He is trying to say to you through that event or person or thought. Ask Him to show you how to change your life to live more fully for Him. Ask him for the freedom, strength and courage to make the changes.

E: End—simply by saying an Our Father.
