A Message from Father Andrew

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This is a very challenging time for the whole of humanity due to the attack by Covid-19, also known as the Coronavirus. It is even more challenging for us as Catholics because we cannot congregate as a parish community to celebrate the Eucharist. I want you to know that Deacon Jim and I are praying for you. I celebrate private Masses daily for you all. I invite you to take note of the following:

1. On Sunday, I will celebrate Mass at St. Mary's, Warroad at 8: 30 am, and livestream it on Facebook. For this to work, go to Facebook and search for "St. Mary's Catholic Church- Warroad." This will take you to our homepage. Look for a small box named livestreaming Mass and then click on it and you will find the live Mass.
2. I will be available for confessions during these hours: WARROAD (Tuesday 5:15pm-6:15pm; Saturdays 2: 30pm - 3:30 pm); WILLIAM'S (Saturday 4:15 pm - 5:15pm); BAUDETTE (Wednesday 6: 00 pm - 7: 00 pm; Sunday 10:30 am - 11: 30 am). Or by appointment.
3. On Palm Sunday, palms will be blessed and put at the entrances of the Church for those who would like to pick them up.
4. In light of the directives from the Bishop and the Vatican, all Holy Week liturgies will be celebrated privately and livestreamed on Facebook. Please join us in prayers during the most Holy Easter Triduum. This is the schedule: Holy Thursday Mass at 7:00 pm. Good Friday Service at 3: 00pm, Easter Vigil Mass at 8: 30 pm.
5. Due to the executive order from the governor of Minnesota requiring Minnesotan's to stay home, the parish office will be closed from Monday, March 30th to April 10th. However, we shall be available by email and phone. We shall check our voicemail and email messages and get back to you as soon as possible. We also want you to know that Fr. Andrew, Deacon Jim and Terrie Lynn are available to minister to or serve you either in person or by phone anytime.
6. Our Church buildings will remain open for private prayer at anytime and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will continue at the usual times except on Holy Thursday.
7. We would like to thank all of you who have continued to support our parishes financially, either by online contributions or by mailing your envelopes. For those who would like to make their contributions online, this is how you can do it. For Warroad go to <https://stmaryswarroad.org/>, in top menu far right click **Online Giving**, follow the steps. For Baudette and Williams, drop them off at the rectory, mail them in, or use the link provided on page 3 of the bulletin to give online.
