

Vatican modifies Distribution of Ashes on Ash Wednesday

Next Wednesday, February 17th is Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of the holy season of lent. Here in our three parishes, we shall have Mass at 8: 30 am and 7: 15 pm in St. Mary's, Warroad and 5: 15 pm in Sacred Heart, Baudette. Due to the health situation caused by Covid-19, distributing ashes on the forehead of each person is problematic this year. The Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments published a note instructing priests to follow the ancient and common practice found in Rome and in a number of countries where ashes are sprinkled on the head. The person receiving the ashes should kneel or make a deep bow when receiving the ashes. The priest or a minister assisting with the distribution will sprinkle the ashes on each person's head without saying anything.
