6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Brothers and sisters, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do,
do everything for the glory of God.” - 1 Corinthians 10:31

Do a quick check of your priorities. Where does God rank in that list? If He's not first, you have some work to do. Putting God first in everything helps us from putting other “gods” (like our pride, ego, money and possessions) before God. Lenten Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Stations of the Cross

& Adoration at Sacred Heart

This year during Lent we will be praying the Stations of the Cross each Friday at 3:00pm, beginning on February 16th. Following Stations of the Cross there will be an opportunity to spend some time in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the Tabernacle. Many times we talk of what we are going to “Give Up” during Lent. This may be an opportunity to “Add Something” to your Lenten observance. During this parish year of the National Eucharistic Revival it is our chance as parishioners to grow in our devotion to the Body of Christ, so that next year we will be able to share that devotion with others!
