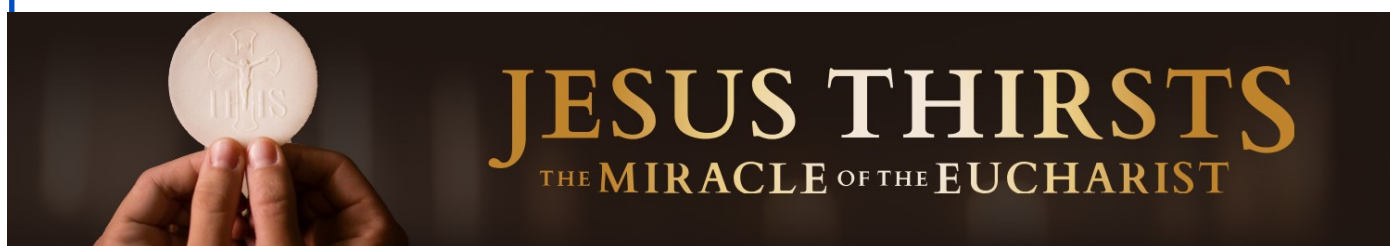
is held on the 4th Sunday of the month beginning after Mass and continuing until 2:00 PM.
