

In order to enrich our faith and better prepare ourselves to share our faith as we are called to with the Eucharistic Revival, we have a great resource in Formed.org. Please sign-up and enjoy the content provided.

1. Go to [Formed.org/signup](https://www.formed.org/signup)
2. In "Find your parish" type Warroad and select St Mary from the drop down, and hit "NEXT"
3. Type in your name and email and select "Sign up"
4. When returning to watch videos simply go to Formed.org, hit menu, (the three horizontal bars) and hit sign in.

Everyone in the three parishes has a subscription allowing you to take in anything that they offer, which is a treasure trove of good Catholic teachings, movies, etc. Please do not share this with people outside the parishes as Formed has given us a great rate, and subscriptions is how they stay solvent.

How would your life change if you spent an hour each day before the Blessed Sacrament? Try not to dismiss the question. I realize that for most people this is not possible, but consider it for a moment anyway. How would your life change? Get lost in that reflection for a few moments. Think on it as you go about your day.

Now, consider this. What is possible? One hour a week? One hour each month? 10 minutes each day? Because whatever is possible, you should grasp it and allow the power of the Eucharist to pour into your soul.

It has been observed that people emulate the five people they spend the most time with—for better or worse. Make Jesus one of those five people. Spending time in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist will transform you and your life in ways you cannot even begin to imagine.

Eucharistic Adoration


is held on the 4th Sunday of the month beginning
