

Oct. 6, 2024

Our meeting began after a prayer.

1. A request/reminder was made by Deacon Jim to join Formed.org. It has numerous videos and other resources to help build and enhance our Catholic faith. It was suggested that an effort would be made to help as many parishioners as possible register on-line for this service under a combined subscription with St. Mary's in Warroad.
2. A discussion commenced about the Bell Tower. A variety of questions were asked and several suggestions were made. It was decided to continue to research options. While repairs are needed to the bell tower, the bell will remain here at Sacred Heart.
3. Term limits were discussed and the Council will review the procedure to elect new members.
4. The Religious Education Committee and the teachers are prepared for the upcoming year. It will start this coming week.
 - a. Confirmation will be held on Sunday, May 4 at 8:30 AM at St. Mary's in Warroad.
 - b. Children's Masses are being planned – I before advent and I following Easter.
5. The last Mass at St. Joseph's in Williams this fall will be November 16. St. Joseph's will be re-open for Mass on Saturday, May 3, 2025.
6. The Women's Group is preparing for the Christmas Tea. The Bible in a Year Study is going really well and plans are being made to continue with another study in the future.

Our next scheduled meeting will be on January 12, 2025.
