“And Jesus said to him, ‘Go your way; your faith has made you well.’ And immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.” (MARK 10:52) Faith is believing in something even though you may not be able to physically see it. Many people think that miracles don’t happen anymore. This is hard, but try to focus on the positive and not the negative things in your life. When you focus on your blessings instead of your hardships, miracles will seem common. You will see God’s active presence in your daily life. You will begin to develop an attitude of gratitude.

Eucharistic Revival—Year of the Mission: Pillar 1 “Eucharistic Encounter”

Before the most important moments in Christ’s life, he retreated and prayed to his Father in heaven, offering us a model for our lives. In Luke’s Gospel, we read that Jesus went up the Mount of Olives, as was his custom, to pray to the Father in anticipation of the Paschal Mystery that was about to unfold. Before we go out, **we too must encounter our Lord and seek him.**

Pope Francis exhorts us, “Let us make space for the prayer of silent adoration, in which we experience the presence of the Lord, like Moses, like Elijah, like Mary, like Jesus. Have we noticed that we have lost the sense of worship? Let us return to worship. Let us lend the ear of our hearts to the One who, in silence, wants to say to us: ‘I am your God—the God of mercy and compassion, the God of pardon and love, the God of tenderness and care...’ Do we believe that the Lord loves us, that the Lord loves me?” (Homily for Ash Wednesday, 2024). Pope Francis also teaches us that, in Eucharistic liturgy, we are guaranteed an encounter with Christ and his Paschal Mystery. Regardless of where we are in life—regardless of our present spiritual development, vocational state, age, etc.—**we must find time to encounter our Lord in adoration.**

- Be open to encountering Christ in Mass, in prayer, and in worship.
- * Rediscover “the sense of adoration in silence.”
- Open your heart and mind daily to Christ in his Word.
- **Adoration Holy Hour is every 4th Sunday after Mass**
