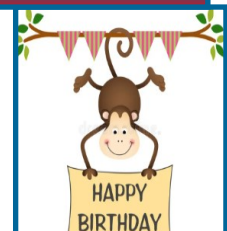

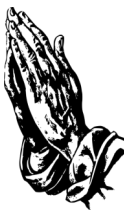

# St. Mary's Faith Formation

Update on the New Family Faith Formation style teaching: Diocese is encouraging parishes to adopt this Family Faith Formation Style of teaching. A letter will go out on Mar 16th (hardcopies for pick-up on Wed Mar 18th).

Here is a brief outline of proposed family formation:

- Families of 2nd-6th graders (parents and youths) would meet every other Wednesdays beginning in October. (Pre-k—1st grade siblings welcome to attend too)
- Faith Formation Coordinator will facilitate monthly sessions, along w/ small group discussions
- Off weeks, families will work on monthly activities
- We will sprinkle in family potlucks once we know how school calendar & faith formation calendar compare.
- 7th—12th graders will still meet each (most) Wednesdays at 6:15pm—7:30pm like previous years.
- The “Opt-in” Confirmation class will be available for 8th graders (and up if you need this sacrament)
- Based on initial feedback during the Feb 25th town hall meeting, we would plan to meet as families at 5:00pm-6:00pm on those Wednesdays. Big picture—we will only have classes 12/14 times in the 6/7 months (Oct—Mar/Apr)
