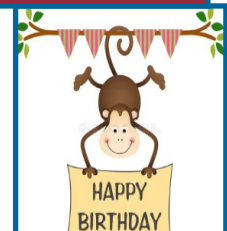
On March 27th, Father Christon will be available for Confessions in Baudette at 2:30pm and again at 3:30pm after the Stations of the Cross.

3rd Sunday of Lent

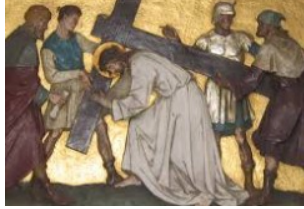
“Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again.” JOHN 4:13

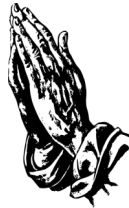

An Invitation From Bishop Andrew Cozzens

We need to be rescued, we have been rescued, and we can learn to rescue others! **I invite you to join me on October 10 at the Alerus Center Ballroom in Grand Forks for Rescue Live, an incredible one-day revival led by Fr. John Riccardo and his team from Acts XXIX.**

During this powerful day together, we will reflect on the heart of the Christian message — what the early Church called the Kerygma, the central proclamation of the Gospel. Through dynamic preaching, prayer, and worship, we will explore the truth of who we are and what God has done to save us. We will consider how we were created out of love by God, how that love was broken through sin and the work of the enemy, and how Jesus Christ has come to rescue us.

Most importantly, we will reflect on what it means to respond to that rescue by living as his disciples. Fr. Riccardo has a remarkable gift for communicating the heart of the Gospel in a way that deeply moves and transforms lives. Throughout the day we will also spend time in prayer together, and I will lead us in Eucharistic Adoration as we encounter the Lord who rescues us.

The day will begin at 8:00 a.m. with worship led by Sarah Kroger and her band, and we will conclude by 5:00 p.m. If you have ever wanted to understand more deeply what Jesus Christ has done for you... if you know someone who needs to hear the truth of salvation... or if you desire to be better equipped to share your faith, this day is for you.

Please mark your calendar now and plan to join us! Registration will open to the public later this spring. Our world is desperately in need of the message that we have been rescued by God, and this day will help us rediscover that truth and learn how to share it with others. I hope to see you on October 10 at Rescue Live in Grand Forks.
