**HVAC Project Update**

At an open meeting in October the condition of our HVAC system was discussed. A short history of our system was given and a presentation was given by a local contractor. Another meeting was held in March. Fr. George Noel, Dean of our Northeast Deanery, laid out steps and documents required by the diocese to proceed with the acquisition of an HVAC system and the fund raising for such a project. A committee has been formed by Father Christon. This committee is working on gathering supporting documents that will promote the move forward with this project. You will be kept updated as decisions are made and permissions from the diocese are granted.

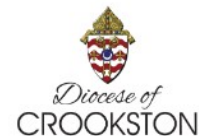

Matt Regitz and Fr. Nick Desimone from Divine Renovation will be speaking to our priests during their annual Spring Priests Convocation May 4-7. They will also present an evening address for the lay faithful on Tuesday, May 5, from 7:00 – 8:15 p.m. at St. Philip's Catholic Church in Bemidji.

Matt and Fr. Nick will offer a focused synopsis of the themes guiding the priests' convocation. Drawing from their sessions on missionary conversion and pastoral planning, Matt and Fr. Nick will share how renewal is not merely about structural change, but about spiritual conversion and new life. Through Fr. Nick's practical witness of leading renewal in parish life and Matt's articulation of the vision and the "3 Keys" of parish renewal, the evening event will encourage parishioners to see this moment as an invitation to deeper prayer, courageous leadership, and hopeful participation in the evangelizing mission of the Church.
