## TOTUS TUUS 2026 July 11th—18th 2026

Our summer program again this year is Totus Tuus, which means "Totally Yours" in Latin. Totus Tuus is a fun and energetic parish-based summer catechetical program for both grade school-age children and junior and senior high school youth. They gather college students and seminarians into teams of four to train them and send them out on the road to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ in various parishes throughout the Diocese of Crookston. Their youthfulness, energy, and ability to witness to the Faith make these teachers particularly effective with children and young people.

Totus Tuus is open to those entering grades 1-12! Please **Register by June 15th** for this year's Totus Tuus Program. **The cost is \$40 per youth (capped at 3, for max payment of \$120 per family).** This fee covers daily snacks for younger grades (1st-6th grade students bring sack lunch), daily team meal, donut Sunday, end of week bbq/activities; and evening meals for middle/high school students. (We are not buying t-shirts this year).

We are excited Roseau families will join us this year as well.

The daily schedule: 1st-6th graders, Mon-Fri (July 13-17) from 9am-2:30pm; and 7th-12th, Sun-Thurs evenings (July 12-16), 5:30pm-8:15pm. We will display a detailed schedule on the bulletin board and send to participating families first part of July. We will let you know when we will offer daily Mass as part of this program, all are invited to attend.

The team will join us for Mass on July 12th at 8:30am followed by donuts and meet & greet.
